Runners in the Baltimore Marathon and Baltimore Half-Marathon will pass close to the Homewood campus on Saturday, Oct. 10, causing traffic delays.

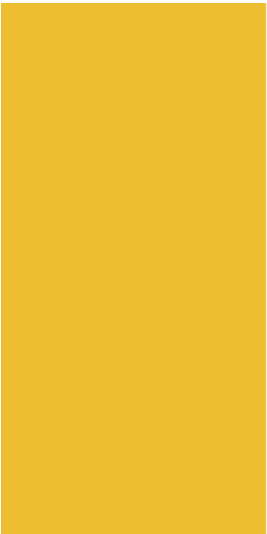
